2nd Day (29/05/2020)

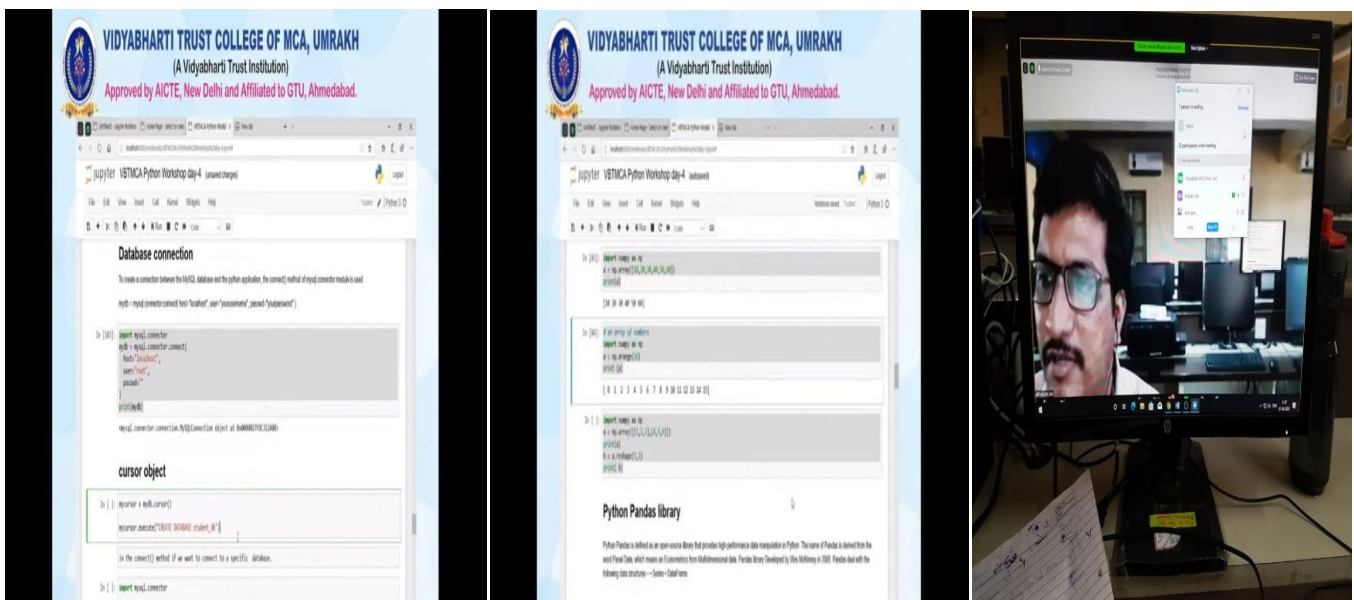
