What is CMAT?

- Common Management Admission Test (CMAT) is a National-level test conducted by the All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE) for admission to all management and technical programs in AICTE-approved institutions. The responsibility of NTA is limited to inviting online application, conduct of entrance test, declaration of results and providing scores to AICTE.
- The exam is accepted by more than 1500 MBA/MCA colleges in India to select candidates for their MBA/MCA or PGDM programs. The difficulty level of the CMAT exam tends to be on the lower side compared to other exams like CAT, GMAT and XAT.

Why CMAT?

- To secure admission in repute institute of MBA/MCA as number of MBA/MCA colleges in India that accept the CMAT.
- To get benefit of TFW Scheme. TFWS is actually a monitory / financial assistance for meritorious students who have scored good marks in MBA/MCA CMAT entrance examinations and are opting for MBA/MCA admissions. Under this scheme, the tuition fee of the aspirant is waived. Rest of the fees should be payed by the beneficiary.
- To make yourself differentiate from the huge number of bachelor students passing as well as to secure first admission in any MBA/MCA colleges.
- Women and reserved category candidates get the advantage of category to secure admission in any MBA/MCA colleges.

Who is eligible for CMAT?

A candidate in the final year of graduation or having completed their bachelor's degree is eligible for CMAT.

CMAT Exam Pattern-2024

- CMAT is composed of 100 questions, and its time duration is 3 hrs.
- It is an objective test that is designed to check the general knowledge and aptitude of the candidates.
- There are no individual sectional time limits in CMAT, which means it is up to the test-taker to maintain a balance among different sections.

2	Click on the "Registration" link	Locate it on the homepage or under the "New Candidate Registration" section.	
3	Create an account	Enter your name, email address, and phone number to create a user account	
4	Verify your email address	Click on the verification link sent to your email to activate your account	
5	Fill out the online application form	Provide personal information, academic details, contact information, and choose exam cities	
6	Upload required documents	Scanned copy of passport-sized photograph, signature, graduation marksheets, etc.	
7	Pay the application fee	Online payment through net banking, credit card, or debit card	
8	Submit the application form	Review all information and click on the "Submit" button	
9	Download confirmation page	Save a copy of the confirmation page for future reference	
10	Download admit card	Access the admit card from the official CMAT website a few days before the exam	

Documents Required for Registration

- The photograph can be in black and white or colour, but it must have sharp contrast.
- The scanned copy of the signature and photo must be in JPG or JPEG format.
- The scanned photo should be between 10 and 200 kb in size.
- ✤ The size of the scanned signature should be between 4 and 30 kb.
